# **About the Project**

This Action was aimed at increasing the capacity of key local stakeholders in the Veneto region (Italy), Edo and Lagos states (Nigeria) as well as in Sweden to tackle human trafficking and deal with its evolving dynamics and trends.

To this end, the Action paid special attention to the trafficking of girls and young women, as well as the strengths and weaknesses of the prevention, protection and rehabilitation systems in the three countries, while promoting knowledge-based policymaking in the respective countries and reinforcing transnational cooperation on the topic.



This MPF project was implemented by the University of Venice (IUAV) in cooperation with Nigerian Women Association, Pathfinders Justice Initiative, Equality ATI and Associazione 2050.

### In-depth qualitative research

In-depth qualitative research on emerging and evolving trends in the field of trafficking in human beings (THB) was conducted to develop a deeper understanding of the dynamics behind the transit of victims and to enable an analysis of the strengths and weaknesses of prevention and protection systems in Italy, Sweden and Nigeria.



## **Capacity building**

This activity aimed to improve key stakeholders' understanding of the multifaceted aspects of human trafficking and to provide capacity building towards a more integrated approach to victim protection. Workshops and training sessions were organised for law enforcement officers, cultural and language mediators, NGOs, community leaders and other key stakeholders, focusing on prevention and protection, in Italy, and rehabilitation, in Nigeria.

### Support to transnational cooperation

The Action facilitated the organisation of several international webinars to exchange key topics, challenges and best practices in THB management. These webinars were attended by almost 500 people from 20 different countries, representing a total of 234 organisations.





Awareness-raising sought to promote information and effective measures against the (re-)trafficking of victims within cities and in remote areas outside urban centres in Nigeria. Activities included the launch of a pilot Helpdesk in Lagos for victim returnees, training sessions for selected college and high school teachers in Lagos and Edo State to support them in the preparation of ad hoc awareness-raising modules, and finally events and visibility materials distributed in Italy and Nigeria.
