#### **About the Project**

This action aimed at strengthening institutional and border management capacities as well as cross border cooperation of the Border Police Department of Moldova. This was achieved through knowledge transfer and implementation of an e-learning platform in line with Frontex's Common Core Curricula allowing for alignment and conformity with the latest development of the European Integrated Border Management (IBM) concept.



This MPF project was implemented by the General Inspectorate of Border Police (Romania) in collaboration with the Border Police Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs (Republic of Moldova).

# **Deployment of a Long-Term Expert**

In order to contribute to the implementation of the national Integrated Border Management (IBM) concept and strengthen the institutional capacity, a Romanian Long-Term Expert (LTE) was deployed to Moldova during 6,5 months to provide in-house support to the local authorities.



## **Training sessions for specialised staff in Romania**

A total of 84 Moldovan officials with competences in IBM participated in three training sessions of five days each, which aimed at enhancing their knowledge and skills on relevant topics such as migration policy, refugee crisis management etc.







## Participation in international working groups in Poland

This activity allowed two Moldovan experts to participate in the Annual Training Conference "Educational technology for border and coast guard training" organised in Warsaw at Frontex HQ. Besides an improvement of knowledge and exposure to new practices, this also increased the specialisation of the Moldovan participants and allowed for post-event knowledge sharing and cross-application with other practices.



## **Creation of an e-learning** platform

As a result of this Action, an e-learning platform was created in order to enhance the institutional capacity of the Moldovan Border Police Department through transfer of knowledge in the field of IBM. This will allow for a centralized data management and will contribute to an increased specialization for staff. Twelve Moldovan experts on 5 training facilities were trained on the use and administration of the platform to ensure sustainability.
